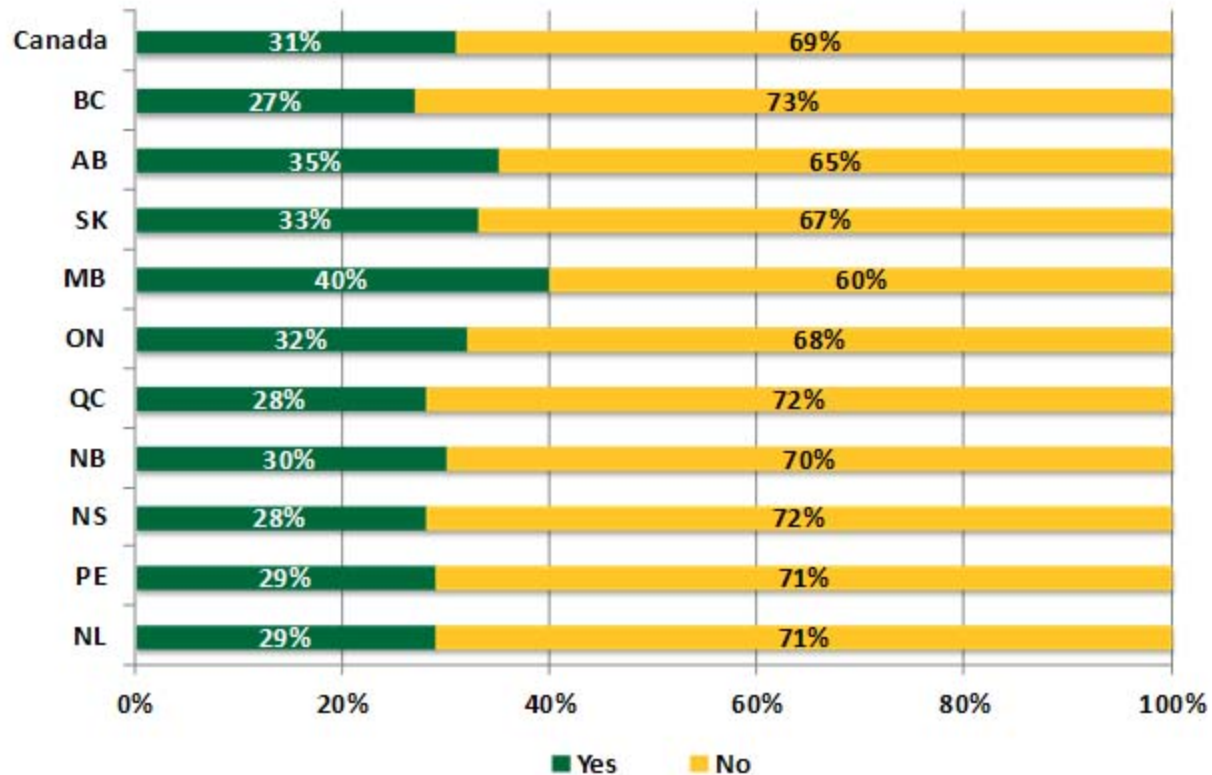


Question:

Do you feel you will have sufficient savings put away for retirement to maintain your current lifestyle?



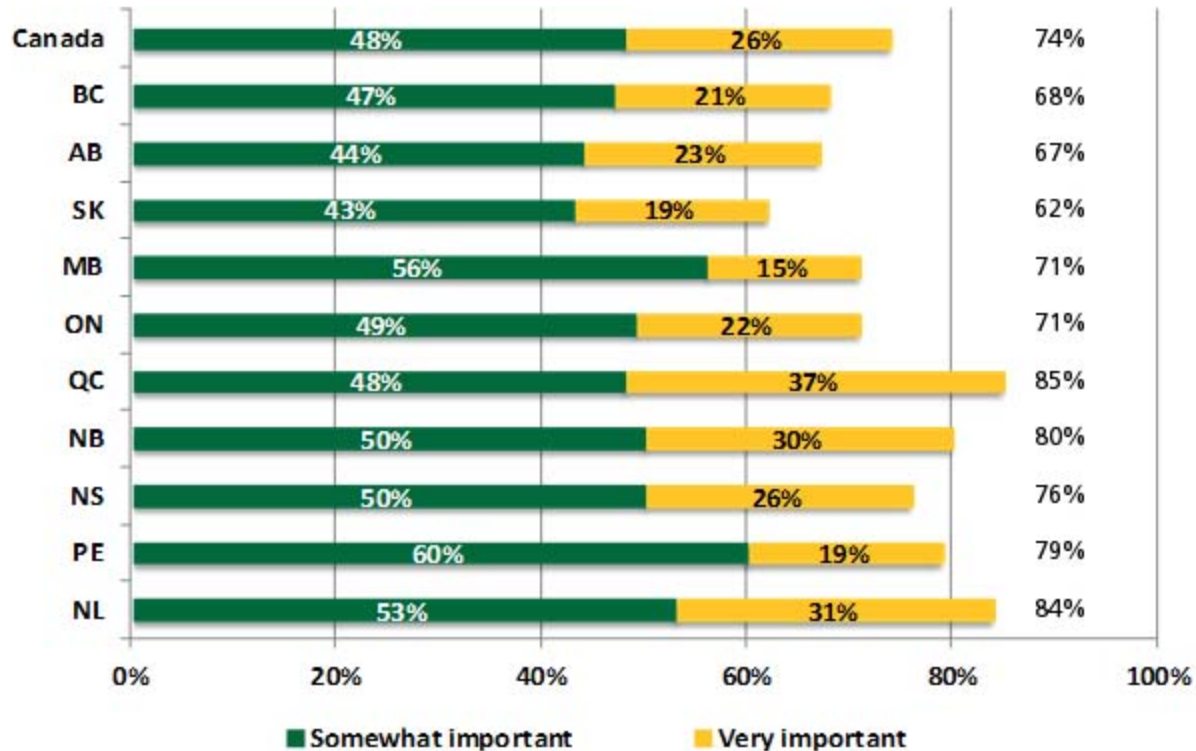
Canadians are worried about their retirement savings

- 7 of 10 Canadians feel they won't be able to maintain their current lifestyle in retirement
- With the exception of Manitoba, where slightly more people believe they will be able to maintain their lifestyle in retirement (40%), there was little provincial variation
- The following are slightly more likely to believe they can maintain their lifestyle in retirement:
 - Individuals with a household income of \$100k+ (43%)
 - Public-sector employees (38%)
 - Individuals who have access and participate in a workplace retirement plan (38%)
 - University graduates (36%)
- Age or gender had very little impact

Base = all workers

Question:

How important is it to you that your province introduce legislation so PRPPs are available to you?



The majority believe it is important their own provinces introduce PRPPs

- Three-quarters of Canadians believe it is important their own provinces introduce PRPPs
- Although the majority of people in all provinces say it is important their province introduce PRPPs, residents of Quebec and Newfoundland were more likely to believe it is important
- Individuals with a household income of \$50k-\$99k were the most likely to say it is important their province introduce PRPPs (80% vs. 77% for <\$50k, and 63% for \$100k+)

Base = those whose workplace doesn't offer a retirement plan, including self-employed
